Proposed Changes to Diocesan Support

- Capacity funding from Church Commissioners
- This is to be used to fund roles in the Diocesan Team
- This needs to cover Schools, Vicarages and Parish Property
- Emissions come from schools (50%), Parishes (30%), Vicarages (20%)





Energy Footprint Tool data Across the Diocese

- For 2022 176 churches provided complete EFT returns
- This is 49% of churches
- For 2021 data we had a return of 22%
- Average across the Diocese was around 30 tonnes of Co2e
- Average across the CoE is around 20 tonnes





EFT data in Richmond and Barnes

- Average return rate for the Archdeaconry of Wandsworth 46%
- Richmond and Barnes 87%
- Total 289.4 tonnes
- Average 18.4
- 43 tonnes offset





Upcoming Eco Church changes

- Proposed changes to church Building section
- This is to keep in line with CoE net zero target of 2030
- Central church funding to support additional capacity for Eco Church Team
- Reform being led by Deborah Colvin, who led the Eco Team at St James's Piccadilly.
